NOTICE OF HEARING ON DISTRICT RULES AMENDMENTS
FEBRUARY 19, 2020 at 9:00 a.m.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to all interested persons in DeWitt County, Texas:

That the Board of Directors of the Pecan Valley Groundwater Conservation District ("District") will hold a public hearing to discuss, consider, receive public comments, and potentially act upon adoption of amendments to the District's Rules regulating water wells in DeWitt County, Texas. The proposed amendments to the Rules include changes and/or additions related to the following: definitions; water well exemptions; aggregation of production; wells within a public water system service area; groundwater production limitations; transport permits; standards of completion for water wells; well registration fees; hearings; notice of hearings; filing of documents; uncontested applications; contested applications; hearings conducted by the State Office of Administrative Hearings; Board action on applications; aquifer storage and recovery and brackish production zones; and organizational and conforming changes.

The hearing will be held on Wednesday, February 19, 2020, at 9:00 a.m. at the District office, located at 1009 N. Esplanade St., Cuero, Texas 77954. Comments on the proposed Rules Amendments may be presented in written or verbal form at the hearing, and persons interested in submitting written comments on the proposed Rules Amendments in advance may do so by sending comments to the District. Any person who desires to appear at the hearing and present comments may do so in person, by legal representative, or both. The hearing posted in this notice may be recessed from day to day or continued where appropriate. At the conclusion of the hearing or any time or date thereafter, the proposed Rules Amendments may be adopted in the form presented or as amended based upon comments received from the public, District staff, consultants, or members of the Board.

A copy of the proposed Rules Amendments will be available 20 days before the date of the hearing by requesting a copy by email to director@pvgcd.org, by accessing the District's website at www.pvgcd.org, or by reviewing or copying the proposed Rules Amendments in person at the District office located at 1009 N. Esplanade St., Cuero, Texas 77954. The District is committed to compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).
