

## PECAN VALLEY GROUNDWATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT

### Notice of Proposed Permit Issuance

Notice is given in accordance with Rule 6.1.6: General Permitting Policies and Procedures and Rule 15.4: Uncontested Permit Hearing Procedures of the Rules of the District that the Pecan Valley Groundwater Conservation District proposes to issue a production permit authorizing the operating of a non-exempt use on March 16, 2021.

**Drilling and Operating Permit Application from South Texas Materials, LLC on Ann Mary V. Williams Estate Property.** This permit is for Industrial use. The Operating Permit Application is requesting 50 AF of water per year from this water well. This would be a combined total of 51.50 AF of water per year from two water wells. This property is located on Thomaston River Road near Cuero and involves 265.689 acres.

**Operating Permit Application from Repsol Oil and Gas USA, LLC on Jeannie Heard et al property.** This permit is for Mining Oil and Gas use. The Operating Permit Application is requesting 34.79 AF of water per year from this water well. This would be a combined total of 69.58 AF of water per year from two water wells. This property is located on Alfred Blaschke Road near Nordheim and involves 139.18 acres.

**Operating Permit Application from Repsol Oil and Gas USA, LLC on Jeannie Heard et al property.** This permit is for Mining Oil and Gas use. The Operating Permit Application is requesting 34.79 AF of water per year from this water well. This would be a combined total of 69.58 AF of water per year from two water wells. This property is located on Alfred Blaschke Road near Nordheim and involves 139.18 acres.

**Operating Permit Application from Repsol Oil and Gas USA, LLC on Arent Family Limited Partnership property.** This permit is for Mining Oil and Gas use. The Operating Permit Application is requesting 95.84 AF of water per year from this water well. This property is located on Maron Road near Nordheim and involves 191.67 acres.
