**Notice of Proposed Permit Issuance**

Notice is given in accordance with Chapter 551, Government Code (V.T.C.A.) Texas Open Meeting Act and Texas Water Code Section 36.404 that the Pecan Valley Groundwater Conservation District Board of Directors will hold a public meeting on Tuesday, May 18, 2021 at 9:00 a.m. at the Pecan Valley Groundwater Conservation District Office, located at 1009 N. Esplanade Street, Cuero, TX. The purpose of the meeting and hearing is to hear public comment and consider possible action on issuance of production permits authorizing the operation of a non-exempt use:

**Operating Permit Amendment Application from Marianne Vaughn Bennett on Ann Mary V. Williams estate property.** This permit is for Industrial use. The Operating Permit Amendment Application is requesting 30 AF of water per year from this water well. This would be a combined total of 80 AF of water per year from two water wells. This property is located on Thomaston River Road near Cuero and involves 265.689 acres.

**Operating Permit Application from Steven Wehlmann, Sr.** This permit is for Commercial use. The Operating Permit Amendment Application is requesting 3 AF of water per year from this water well. This property is located on FM 2718 near Cuero and involves 28.59 acres.

**Operating Permit Applications (4) from Ensign Natural Resources on Howard McElroy property.** These four permits are for Mining Oil and Gas use. The Operating Permit Applications are requesting 37.25 AF of water per year per well from three water wells and 37.26 AF of water per year from one water well. This would be a combined total of 149.01 AF of water per year from four water wells. This property is located on Garfield Road near Yorktown and involves 298.02 acres.

**Operating Permit Application from Ensign Natural Resources on Nordheim Heartland Ranch, LLC property.** This permit is for Mining Oil and Gas use. The Operating Permit Application is requesting 51.70 AF of water per year from this water well. This would be a combined total of 96.70 AF of water per year from two water wells. This property is located on Cottonpatch Road near Yorktown and involves 199.39 acres.

**Drilling Permit Application from Burlington Resources on Burlington Resources property.** The Drilling Permit Application is for the beneficial use for Mining Oil and Gas and proposes a well depth of approximately 3400 feet, with an estimated 600 gpm production rate. This property is located on Haase Road near Yorktown and involves 206.683 acres. The Operating Permit Application will be submitted at a later date.

Any person who intends to contest a permit application must provide written notice of that intent to the District at 1009 N. Esplanade, Cuero, Texas 77954 at least three calendar days prior to the proposed date of permit issuance. If the District does not receive a written notice of protest, the General Manager may issue an uncontested permit, as allowed by District Rule 6.1.6: General Permitting Policies and Procedures and Rule 15.4: Uncontested Permit Hearing Procedures.
