Texas Open Meeting Act and Texas Water Code Section 36.404 that the Pecan Valley Groundwater Conservation District Board of Directors will hold a public meeting on July 20, 2021 at 9:00 a.m. at the Pecan Valley Groundwater Conservation District Office, located at 1009 N. Esplanade Street, Cuero, TX. The purpose of the meeting and hearing is to hear public comment and consider possible action on issuance of an amended operating permit authorizing the operation of a non-exempt use:

Operating Permit Amendment Application from Burlington Resources on Burlington Resources property. The Operating Permit Amendment Application is for the beneficial use for Mining Oil and Gas. The Operating Permit Amendment Application is requesting 200 AF of water per year from this water well. This well's construction complies with District Rule 8.1 regarding additional production limits on deep water wells and lab results of Total Dissolved Solids. This property is located on Respondek Road near Westhoff and involves 100.84 acres.
