**Notice of Proposed Permit Issuance**

Notice of meeting is given in accordance with Chapter 551, Government Code, Texas Open Meetings Act and Texas Water Code Sections 36.064 and 36.404 that the Pecan Valley Groundwater Conservation District Board of Directors will hold a public meeting on August 17, 2021 at 9:00 a.m. at the Pecan Valley Groundwater Conservation District Office, located at 1009 N. Esplanade Street, Cuero, TX. The purpose of the meeting and hearing is to conduct regular District business and hear public comment and consider possible action on issuance of operating permits authorizing the operation of a water well for non-exempt use.

**Operating Permit Applications from BPX Properties on Diana Guevara Living Trust property.** The two Operating Permit Applications are for the beneficial use for Mining Oil and Gas. One Operating Permit Application is requesting 30 Acre-Feet of water per year and the second Operating Permit Application is requesting 15 Acre-Feet of water per year. This would be a combined total of 45 Acre-Feet of water per year from two water wells. This property is located on Williams Road near Concrete and involves 125 acres.

**Operating Permit Application from BPX Properties on Erwin Landgrebe property.** The Operating Permit Application is for the beneficial use for Mining Oil and Gas. The Operating Permit Application is requesting 20 Acre-Feet of water per year from this water well. This property is located on Cabeza Road near Nordheim and involves 81.77 acres.

Any person who intends to contest a permit application must provide written notice of that intent to the District at 1009 N. Esplanade, Cuero, Texas 77954 at least three calendar days prior to the proposed date of permit issuance. If the District does not receive a written notice of protest, the General Manager may issue an uncontested permit, as allowed by District Rule 6.1.6: General Permitting Policies and Procedures and Rule 15.4: Uncontested Permit Hearing Procedures.
