### Notice of Proposed Permit Issuance and Public Meeting

Notice is given in accordance with Chapter 551, Government Code and Texas Water Code Section 36.404 that the Pecan Valley GCD Board of Directors will hold a public hearing on November 15, 2022 at 9:00 a.m. at the District Office, located at 1009 N. Esplanade St., Cuero, TX. The purpose of the meeting and permit hearing is to conduct regular District business and hear public comment and consider possible issuance on the following permit applications.

**Drilling and Operating Permit Application from Advantek EagleFord, LLC.** The Application is for the beneficial use for Industrial purposes and is requesting 2 AF of water per year from this water well. This property is located at US Hwy 87 N near Westhoff and involves 9.308 acres.


**Drilling and Operating Permit Application from Twisted Roots Nursery, Inc. on property owned by Russell D. Johnson II, Clayton C. Johnson, Johnson Revocable Living Trust and Jason Johnson.** The Application is for the beneficial use for Agriculture purposes and is requesting 32.06 Acre-Feet of water per year from this water well. This property is located on FM 766 near Gonzales and involves 32.06 acres.

**Operating Permit Amendment Application from South Texas Materials, LLC, on property owned by Marianne Vaughn GS Trust.** The Amendment Application is for the beneficial use for Industrial purposes and is requesting an additional 52 Acre-Feet of water for a total of 102 Acre-Feet from this water well. This would be a combined total of 132 Acre-Feet of water per year from two permitted water wells. This property is located on Thomaston River Road near Cuero and involves 265.689 acres.

Any person who intends to contest a permit application must provide written notice to the District at 1009 N. Esplanade, Cuero, Texas 77954, at least three business days prior to the proposed date of issuance and include all requested information in District Rule 15.5 (a-c).
