Notice of Proposed Permit Issuance


Notice is given in accordance with Rule 6.1 General Permitting Policies and Policies that the Pecan Valley Groundwater Conservation District proposes to issue a production permit authorizing the operation of a non-exempt water well on April 19, 2022.

Operating Permit Application from Tracy Metting. This hearing is to receive public comments on the permit application for the beneficial use of Irrigation. The Application is requesting 25 AF of water per year from this water well. This would be a combined total of 53 Acre Feet per year from two water wells. This property is located on VFW Road near Yorktown and involves 106.82 acres.

Any person who intends to contest a permit application must provide written notice of that intent to the District at 1009 N. Esplanade, Cuero, Texas 77954 at least three days before the proposed date of issuance as published in the public notice.
