Notice of Public Hearing and Public Meeting

Notice is given in accordance with Chapter 551, Government Code, Texas Open Meetings Act and Texas Water Code Sections 36.064 and 36.404 that the Pecan Valley GCD Board of Directors will hold a public hearing on April 19, 2022 at 9:00 a.m. at the Pecan Valley Groundwater Conservation District Office, located at 1009 N. Esplanade Street, Cuero, TX. The purpose of the meeting and hearing is to conduct regular District business and hear public comment and consider possible action on the following:

Operating Permit Amendment Application from Burlington Resources on Burlington Resources property. The Application is for the beneficial use for Mining Oil and Gas and requests 200 Acre-Feet of water per year from this water well. This well's construction complies with District Rule 8.1 regarding additional production limits on deep water wells and lab analysis reports of Total Dissolved Solids. This property is located on FM 238 near Westhoff and involves 103.48 acres.


Operating Permit Amendment Applications (2) from Burlington Resources on Burlington Resources property. The two Applications are for the beneficial use for Mining Oil and Gas. One Operating Permit Amendment Application is requesting 330 Acre-Feet of water per year. The second Operating Permit Amendment Application is requesting 200 Acre-Feet of water per year. This would be a combined total of 530 Acre-Feet of water per year from two water wells. Construction of both wells complies with District Rule 8.1 regarding additional production limits on deep water wells and lab analysis reports of Total Dissolved Solids. This property is located on FM 240 near Westhoff and involves 265.30 acres.

Operating Permit Application from Burlington Resources on Burlington Resources property. The Operating Permit Application is for the beneficial use for Mining Oil and Gas. The Application is requesting 364 Acre-Feet of water per year from this water well. This well's construction complies with District Rule 8.1 regarding additional production limits on deep water wells. This property is located on Gus Meyer Road near Yorktown and involves 364.527 acres.

Any person who intends to contest a permit application must provide written notice to the District at 1009 N. Esplanade, Cuero, Texas 77954 at least three calendar days prior to the proposed date of permit issuance.
