Notice of Public Hearing and Public Meeting

Notice is given in accordance with Chapter 551, Government Code, Texas Open Meetings Act and Texas Water Code Sections 36.064 and 36.404 that the Pecan Valley GCD Board of Directors will hold a public hearing on August 15, 2022 at 8:00 a.m. at the Pecan Valley Groundwater Conservation District Office, located at 1009 N. Esplanade Street, Cuero, TX. The purpose of the meeting and hearing is to conduct regular District business and hear public comment and consider possible action on the following:

Operating Permit Application from BPX Operating Company on Leonard Kolodziejczyk Estate property. The Application is for the beneficial use for Mining Oil and Gas and is requesting 40 Acre-Feet of water per year. This property is located on Rogge-Seifert Rd. near Nordheim and involves 984.06 acres.

Operating Permit Applications (2) from BPX Operating Company on Martin O'Connor Ranch, Ltd. property. The two Applications are for the beneficial use for Mining Oil and Gas. Each application is requesting 50 Acre-Feet of water per year. This would be a combined total of 100 Acre-Feet of water per year from two water wells. This property is located on FM 2542 near Cuero and involves 1738.05 acres.


Drilling and Operating Permit Application from Edward L. Clegg. The Application is for the beneficial use for Agriculture purposes and is requesting 5 Acre-Feet of water per year. This property is located on Thomaston River Road near Cuero and involves 297.4 acres.

Operating Permit Application from Burlington Resources on Burlington Resources property. The Application is for the beneficial use for Mining Oil and Gas, requesting 213.36 Acre-Feet of water per year. This would be a combined total of 413.36 Acre-Feet of water per year from two water wells. Construction of both wells comply with District Rule 8.1.3 regarding additional production limits on deep water wells and well analysis of TDS levels. This property is located on Haase Road near Yorktown and involves 206.683 acres.

Any person who intends to contest a permit application must provide written notice to the District at 1009 N. Esplanade, Cuero, Texas 77954 at least three calendar days prior to the proposed date of permit issuance.
