Notice of Public Hearing and Public Meeting

Notice is given in accordance with Chapter 551, Government Code, Texas Open Meetings Act and Texas Water Code Sections 36.064 and 36.404 that the Pecan Valley GCD Board of Directors will hold a public hearing on May 17, 2022 at 10:30 a.m. at the Pecan Valley Groundwater Conservation District Office, located at 1009 N. Esplanade Street, Cuero, TX. The purpose of the meeting and hearing is to conduct regular District business and hear public comment and consider possible action on the following:

Operating Permit Application from Ensign Natural Resources on Charles and Bonnie Riedesel property. The Application is for the beneficial use for Mining Oil and Gas and requests 36.55 Acre-Feet of water per year from this water well. This would be a combined total of 96.55 AF of water per year from two water wells. This property is located on FM 240 near Yorktown and involves 193.1 acres.

Operating Permit Applications (2) from Ensign Natural Resources on Eva Gohmert property. The two Applications are for the beneficial use for Mining Oil and Gas. One Application is requesting 77.23 Acre-Feet of water per year and the other Application is requesting 77.24 Acre-Feet of water per year. This would be a combined total of 154.47 Acre-Feet of water per year from two water wells. This property is located on Spies Road near Yorktown and involves 312.94 acres.


Operating Permit Application from Ensign Natural Resources on Joyce Bower and Kyle Hay property. The Application is for the beneficial use for Mining Oil and Gas and requests 118.78 Acre-Feet of water per year from this water well. This property is located on FM 240 near Yorktown and involves 237.56 acres.

Operating Permit Application from Tanner Klemcke on Klemcke Farm, LLC property. The Application is for the beneficial use for Irrigation and requests 49.449 Acre-Feet of water per year from this water well. This property is located on Meyersville Road near Meyersville and involves 98.898 acres.

Any person who intends to contest a permit application must provide written notice to the District at 1009 N. Esplanade, Cuero, Texas 77954 at least three calendar days prior to the proposed date of permit issuance.
