Notice of Proposed Permit Issuance and Public Meeting

Notice is given in accordance with Chapter 551, Government Code and Texas Water Code Section 36.404 that the Pecan Valley GCD Board of Directors will hold a public hearing on November 21, 2023 at 9:00 a.m. at the District Office, located at 1009 N. Esplanade St., Cuero, TX. The purpose of the meeting and permit hearing is to conduct regular District business and hear public comment and consider possible issuance on the following permit applications.


Operating Permit Amendment Application from SilverBow Resources Operating, LLC. on Chumchal Farms property. The Amendment Application is for the beneficial use for Mining Oil and Gas and requests an increased annual production from 5 Acre-Feet to 50.85 Acre-Feet of water per year from this water well. This property is located on Rathkamp-Dreyer Rd. near Yoakum and involves 101.70 acres.

Operating Permit Application from EOG Resources, Inc. on Boening Properties II, LLC property. The Application is for the beneficial use for Mining Oil and Gas and requests 131.125 Acre-Feet of water per year from this water well. This property is located on Dagg Road near Yoakum and involves 515.77 acres.

Operating Permit Application from EOG Resources, Inc. on Armstrong Family Revocable Living Trust property. The application is for the beneficial use for Mining Oil and Gas and requests 181.46 Acre-Feet of water per year from this water well. This property is located on Morris Community Rd. near Yoakum and involves 362.93 acres.

Any person who intends to contest a permit application must provide written notice to the District at 1009 N. Esplanade, Cuero, Texas 77954, at least three business days prior to the proposed date of issuance and include all requested information in District Rule 15.5 (a-c).
