
## Notice of Proposed Permit Issuance and Public Meeting

Notice is given in accordance with Chapter 551, Government Code and Texas Water Code Section 36.404 that the Pecan Valley GCD Board of Directors will hold a public meeting on July 16, 2024 at 9:10 a.m. at the District Office, located at 1009 N. Esplanade St., Cuero, TX. The purpose of the meeting is to conduct regular District business and hear public comment and consider possible issuance on the following permit application. This application is for the beneficial use for Mining Oil and Gas.

Operating Permit Application from Burlington Resources on Robert Schendel property. The application requests an annual production of 650 Acre-Feet of water from this well. This well complies with District Rule 8.1 regarding additional production limits on deep wells with elevated Total Dissolved Solids analysis. This would be an annual production total of 725 Acre-Feet of water from two water wells. This property is located on Schendel Rd. near Yorktown and involves 798.03 acres.

Any person who intends to contest a permit application must provide written notice to the District at 1009 N. Esplanade, Cuero, Texas 77954, at least three business days prior to the proposed date of issuance and include all requested information in District Rule 15.5.1 (a-c).
