Notice of Proposed Permit Issuance and Public Meeting


Notice is given in accordance with Chapter 551, Government Code and Texas Water Code Section 36.404 that the Pecan Valley GCD Board of Directors will hold a public meeting on October 22, 2024 at 9:15 a.m. at the District Office, located at 1009 N. Esplanade St., Cuero, TX. The purpose of the meeting is to conduct regular District business and hear public comment and consider possible issuance on the following operating permit applications. All applications are for the beneficial use for Mining Oil and Gas.

Operating Permit Application from BPX Properties on property owned by Darleen Jordan. The application requests an annual production of 25 Acre-Feet of water. This would be a total of 35 Acre-Feet of water per year from two water wells. This property is located on Elroyce Helmers Rd. near Nordheim and involves 74.67 acres.

Operating Permit Application from BPX Properties on property owned by Harvey H. Mueller. The application requests an annual production of 120 Acre-Feet of water. This property is located on Rogge-Seifert Rd. near Nordheim and involves 402.33 acres.

Any person who intends to contest a permit application must provide written notice to the District at 1009 N. Esplanade, Cuero, Texas 77954, at least three business days prior to the proposed date of issuance and include all requested information in District Rule 15.5.1 (a-c).
