

PECAN VALLEY GROUNDWATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT
Notice of Proposed Permit Issuance and Public Meeting

Notice is given in accordance with Chapter 551, Government Code and Texas Water Code Section 36.404 that the Pecan Valley GCD Board of Directors will hold a public meeting on May 21, 2024 at 9:00 a.m. at the District Office, located at 1009 N. Esplanade St., Cuero, TX. The purpose of the meeting is to conduct regular District business and hear public comment and consider possible issuance on the following permit applications. All applications are for the beneficial use for Mining Oil and Gas.

Operating Permit Amendment Application from Burlington Resources on Jendry Family (James, Steven and Dennis) property. The amendment application requests an increased annual production from 20 Acre-Feet to 110 Acre-Feet of water. This property is located on FM 240 near Westhoff and involves 229 acres.

Operating Permit Application from BPX Operating Company on Sheryl Winslow property. The application requests an annual production of 20 Acre-Feet of water. This property is located on FM 2542 near Cuero and involves 618.34 acres.

Operating Permit Application from BPX Operating Company on Barbara Warzecha property. The application requests an annual production of 20 Acre-Feet of water. This property is located on FM 2542 near Cuero and involves 101.25 acres.

Operating Permit Application from BPX Operating Company on David Warzecha property. The application requests an annual production of 20 Acre-Feet of water. This property is located on FM 2542 near Cuero and involves 61.25 acres.

Operating Permit Application from BPX Operating Company on Cullen Stakes property. The application requests an annual production of 40 Acre-Feet of water. This property is located on FM 2542 near Cuero and involves 261.17 acres.

Operating Permit Applications (2) from BPX Operating Company on Sandra Hahn property. The applications request an annual production of 40 Acre-Feet of water per year from each water well. This would be a total of 80 Acre-Feet of water per year from two water wells. This property is located on Walter Mueller Rd/Dubose Ranch Rd near Yorktown and involves 316.5 acres.

Operating Permit Applications (2) from BPX Operating Company on Eric Ibrom property. The applications request an annual total production of 40 Acre-Feet of water per year from one well and 13 Acre-Feet of water per year from another well. This would be a total of 53 Acre-Feet of water per year from two water wells. This property is located on FM 240 near Westhoff and involves 111.59 acres.


Operating Permit Application from BPX Operating Company on Blake Muir property. The application requests an annual production of 60 Acre-Feet of water. This would be a total of 534.89 Acre-Feet of water per year from ten (10) water wells. This property is located on FM 766 near Westhoff and involves 1956.01 acres.

Operating Permit Application from BPX Operating Company on ConocoPhillips property. The application requests an annual production of 30 Acre-Feet of water. This property is located on Matejek Rd. near Yorktown and involves 120.41 acres.

Drilling and Operating Permit Applications (2) from BPX Operating Company on Martin O'Connor Ranch, Ltd. property. The two applications are requesting a combined total of 3,176.10 Acre-Feet per year from the two wells. This would be a total of 3,476.10 Acre-Feet of water per year from five water wells. The proposed construction of both wells will comply with District Rule 8.1 regarding additional production limits on deep wells (approximate 4,000' depth) and operating permit amounts will be contingent on lab analysis of Total Dissolved Solids. This property is located on FM 2542 near Cuero and involves 1,738.05 acres.

Any person who intends to contest a permit application must provide written notice to the District at 1009 N. Esplanade, Cuero, Texas 77954, at least three business days prior to the proposed date of issuance and include all requested information in District Rule 15.5.1 (a-c).
