Notice of Proposed Permit Issuance and Public Meeting

Notice is given in accordance with Chapter 551, Government Code and Texas Water Code Section 36.404 that the Pecan Valley GCD Board of Directors will hold a public meeting on July 15, 2025 at 9:00 a.m. at the District Office, located at 1009 N. Esplanade St., Cuero, TX. The purpose of the meeting is to conduct regular District business and hear public comment and consider possible issuance on the following permit application.

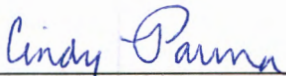
Non-Exempt Drilling and Operating Permit Application from GulfMark Terminals, LLC. The application is for the beneficial use for industrial purposes and requests an annual production of 3 Acre-Feet of water from this water well. This would be an annual total of 13.55 acre-feet of water from four water wells. This property is located on Schlinke Rd. near Cuero and involves 50.298 acres.

Non-Exempt Drilling and Operating Permit Application from Marshall Varner. The application is for the beneficial use for commercial purposes and requests an annual production of 257.3 acre-feet of water from this water well. This well will comply with District Rule 8.1 regarding additional production limits on deep wells. This would be an annual total of 347.3 acre-feet of water from three water wells. This property is located on Hwy 183 N. near Yoakum and involves 347.304 acres.

Non-Exempt Drilling and Operating Permit Applications (4) from BPX Operating Company. The four applications are for the beneficial use for mining oil and gas and request 429.45 Acre-Feet from each water well. This would be an annual total of 1,717.80 Acre-Feet from four water wells. The proposed construction of all four wells will comply with District Rule 8.1 regarding additional production limits on deep wells with elevated TDS levels. The operating permit amounts will be contingent on lab analysis of Total Dissolved Solids from each well. This property is located on FM 2656 near Yorktown and involves 171.78 acres.

Any person who intends to contest a permit application must provide written notice to the District at 1009 N. Esplanade, Cuero, Texas 77954, at least three business days prior to the proposed date of issuance and include all requested information in District Rule 15.5.1 (a-c).
