Operating Permit Application from BPX Properties on James D. Nelson property. The application is for the beneficial use for Mining Oil and Gas and requests an annual production of 25 acre-feet of water from this water well. This property is located on FM 2656 near Yorktown and involves 91.5 acres.

Operating Permit Application from BPX Properties on Alvin Warzecha et al property. The application is for the beneficial use for Mining Oil and Gas and requests an annual production of 39 acre-feet of water from this water well. This property is located on FM 2656 near Yorktown and involves 159.09 acres.

Operating Permit Applications (2) from BPX Properties on H O S Acres, LLC property. The applications are for the beneficial use for Mining Oil and Gas and request an annual production of 30 acre-feet of water from each water well. This would be an annual total of 60 acre-feet of water from two water wells. This property is located on Lincke Rd. near Yorktown and involves 170.5 acres.
