

5. Public Hearing on two Operating Permit Applications – Rosewood Resources
 - a. Public Hearing on two Operating Permit Applications from Rosewood Resources on Michael Albrecht's property for Mining Oil and Gas use. The two applications are each requesting 107.25 acre-feet of water per year for a combined total of 214.5 acre-feet of water per year from two water wells. The construction of both wells complies with District Rule 8.1 regarding additional production limits on deep water wells. This property is located on Metting School Road near Yorktown and involves 214.5 acres.
 - b. Discussion and possible action on operating permit applications.
